Golf Tour for Aston Martin Owners 15-24 November 2017

November in the UK isn't the greatest month, the nights are drawing in, the heating is on, people venture out less. With the exception of the most hardy, cars and clubs are carefully put away waiting for better days...

But it doesn't have to be like that, because we've joined forces with La Manga Club in southern Spain to organise a Spanish Golf Tournament for Aston Martin Owners Club members. At this time of year the weather will be warm and being outside something to be enjoyed instead of endured

For those who wish to drive we have crossings and cabins booked on Brittany Ferries comfortable and fast Cap Finistere which will get into Spain in plenty of time for our first night at the C17th Ducal Palace which is the Parador at Lerma, a favourite with those who have visited before. We then move on for a night at Teruel where our Parador is in spacious grounds on the edge of the town with its medieval centre

La Manga Club has won numerous awards and is regularly voted top sporting resort in Europe. It has hosted the Spanish Open and is regularly used for qualifying events for prestigious championships. We have joined forces with Richard Lemmer who has decades of experience of organising golf events at La Manga Club to run the event. Richard is no mean golfer himself and is also still involved in Barwell Motorsport. For those who like to take things easy we have also organised complimentary access to the indoor pool, sauna and steam room at the very large Spa

For those for whom time is tight we have also organised a fly option which includes the La Manga element only. The nearest airport is Murcia/San Javier which has flights from most UK airports with British Airways, Jet2, Easyjet and Ryanair. It's 25 minutes drive from the airport and at this time of year both flights and car hire should be inexpensive

We will be staying in the 5* Hotel Principe Felipe, but as La Manga Club is a large resort with a range of themed restaurants we'll aim to make sure a good time is had by all. There will of course be a gala dinner and prizegiving on the last night.

The driving group will then head North for a night at Cuenca in C16th Convent Parador which overlooks the gorge and the emblematic hanging houses, one of which houses a modern art collection

Our last night in Spain is in a proper castle—the C12th Castle Parador at Sigüenza where we park just inside the walls. The Castle is the highest point in this charming little town which is worth exploring. On Thursday we leave for Bilbao and a mid afternoon sailing which will get us into Portsmouth in time for the weekend

Wed 15 Nov	Morning departure from Portsmouth on Brittany Ferries Cap Finistere
Thurs 16 Nov	Arrive in Bilbao then drive 130 miles to Lerma to stay in the Parador- a C17th Palace of the Dukes of Lerma. Dominating one side of the Plaza Major, Lerma is a great spot to start a Spanish Tour
Fri 17 Nov	Drive 220 miles to Teruel which is between Madrid and Valencia. The hotel is on the edge of the town which is steeped in history
Sat 18 Nov	Drive 240 miles to La Manga Club for three nights at the 5* hotel Principe Felipe There will be golf on Sunday and Monday and for non-golfers, a wide range of things to do with Murcia and Cartagena both in easy reach
Tues 21 Nov	Drive 220 miles to Cuenca and stay at the Parador which overlooks the gorge. The hotel is very comfortable and the surroundings spectacular
Weds 22 Nov	Drive 120 miles to Sigüenza for a night in the C12th Castle. With a keep, very thick walls, and a dominating position this is every inch the Spanish Castle and a great place for our last night in Spain
Thurs 23 Nov	Drive 220 miles to Bilbao for a mid afternoon ferry departure for Portsmouth
Fr 24 Nov	Late afternoon arrival at Portsmouth
